Dear Parents,

Thank you for your assistance with our self-registration at the beginning of the sessions using the children's names. It is working well so far....!

- ◆ This term, we are organising some visitors to come into Nursery including the Health Visitor, Community Police Officer, Veterinary Assistant and hopefully the local Fire Service. There will be lots of opportunities for children to role play and to think about people who work in our community. We have already set up our own Hairdressing Salon and intend adding a Nail Bar! Please inform us if you would prefer your children not to have nail varnish applied.
- ◆ As you may be aware Reception and Year 1 children engage in our Forest Schools Programme every week. I am currently studying for my Forest School qualification and intend taking the children, in very small groups, from next week to our Forest School designated area. This is situated next to the Nursery grounds, through the gate, and is a totally enclosed area. The children will need to wear old clothes and their wellingtons and will be provided with waterproof all in one suits. I will advise you when your child will have a turn; please watch out for a note later this week!
